### **TASTING NOTES:**

#### **2007 Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon.**

This delicious Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon was aged in a blend of assorted French oak. A rich vibrant crimson red colour.

The bouquet shows strong mulberry and cherry fruit with a hint of under lying French oak, which adds complexity to the bouquet. The Coonawarra region is synonymous for its Cabernet Sauvignon and this wine illustrates just why. In a year most regions faced tough growing conditions we have produced a wine of full and vibrant fruit flavours. Dark red berry and plum fill the mid palate while soft tannins go well with the elegant under lying taste of French oak to make this a very easy drinking Cabernet Sauvignon.

Cellaring: This wine will be drinking beautifully upon release although; will develop well in the bottle with cellaring over the next 5+ years.

#### **2006 Tasmanian Chardonnay**

This classy Tassie Chardonnay was produced from one of Tasmania's finest vineyards from the Coal River Valley in Tasmania's south eastern wine region. Brilliant light straw in colour with vibrant green hues. The wine displays citrus, melon and peach aromas combined and a subtle hint of oak.

Elegantly structured, the wine has excellent intensity. Fresh, fine, tight, balanced and with noticeable texture, this wine has a combination of classic Chardonnay fruits such as nectarine and honeydew melon and red grapefruit.

Cellaring: Good depth and length will allow the wine to age gracefully for up to 7+ years. Soft tannins contribute to a long silky mouthfeel and soft finish, allowing the wine to also be enjoyed in its youth.
